During the digital part of the 66th RAI (July 25 - 26) it is planned that both lectures and Q&A sessions will take place entirely digitally. So if you are already in Mainz on Monday or Tuesday, you are cordially invited to follow the lectures together with us on the big screen. The hybrid part of the conference will take place from July 27 - 29 in the above-mentioned rooms and will be streamed live on the Virtual Venue at the same time.
